And now for the entrees. A guarantee you will never tire of the menu selection at La Hacienda de la Flor. An exceptionally fine choice is the Pechuga a la Naranja, breast of chicken in a superb orange sauce. Absolutely delicious.

Under seafood the "Camarones Imperiales" (giant shrimp stuffed with cheese and wrapped with bacon) or the "Filete de Pescado al Cilantro" (fillet of fish with baby shrimp, mushrooms and onions cooked with white wine and a coriander sauce) are a guarantee to all seafood lovers.

Or try the award winning dish created by Chef Marcelo. "Chile Relleno Emperador" (a poblano pepper stuffed with lobster and cuilacoche) a trully emperor's dish. As if the extensive menu were not enough, you are invited to ask your waiter about the Chef's suggestion for the day, his special creation from fresh ingredients prepared for your enjoyment.

Conclude your dining experience with a dessert or an international flaming coffee. This fine restaurant opens from 2:00 to 10:00 p.m. daily. Although you are welcome to dress casually, you will always receive "Royal" treatment and cuisine when you visit the Royal Villas.
